All proceeds of this fund raiser (every penny!) goes to preservation and restoration of our coastal and cultural resources. Remember that FISH is an all-volunteer organization, which means that there are no salaries or overhead costs.

Why FISH? Why now? Now, more than ever, coastal Florida needs your help. A growing population and the associated development threatens the beauty and function of true Florida shorelines. Preservation of local habitat and working waterfront communities are critical to maintaining healthy fisheries and wildlife.

In 2000, FISH spearheaded an effort to purchase 100 acres of coastal habitat immediately adjacent to the village of Cortez. This parcel of land – **the FISH Preserve** – represents the last undeveloped stretch of waterfront on Sarasota Bay and encompasses mangrove and wetland habitat that are critical to local fisheries. The FISH Preserve is more than just a piece of land. It represents a community's way of life.
